






Example-During the Diwali season, automobile demand in India increases generally, with sales often rising by 30-35% compared to the non-Diwali season.

During the Eid season, market demand in India sees a significant increase across major retail sectors, including apparel, food, jewelry, and travel. A 2025 report noted that Eid-ul-Fitr fueled a 30-50% rise in the product in India.

The economic reaction to the festival seasons is deeply conditioned by the financial health and psychological state of the customer base, resulting in the divergent spending pattern and intense focus on value

At the period of festivals, consumer expenditure and spending increases, which leads to a rise in demand in the market, which leads to a rise in employment for excess production, and due to festivals, the flow of goods and services increases in the economy, which gives a boost to Gross Domestic Product (GDP) growth in an economy



Income-tax Scrutiny Assessments – Procedure, Rights and Practical Insights

Introduction

Income-tax scrutiny assessments constitute a vital mechanism for ensuring tax compliance and safeguarding revenue under the Income-tax Act, 1961. In recent years, the assessment process has undergone a significant transformation with the introduction of technology-driven risk selection, data analytics and the faceless assessment framework. As a result, scrutiny proceedings have become more structured, transparent and time-bound.

For taxpayers as well as professionals, a clear understanding of the scrutiny process is essential to ensure effective representation, timely compliance and minimisation of litigation. This article presents a comprehensive overview of the procedure for income-tax scrutiny cases, along with key rights of taxpayers and practical insights for professionals.

Meaning and Objective of Scrutiny Assessment
A scrutiny assessment is undertaken to verify the correctness of income declared, the validity of deductions and exemptions claimed, and overall compliance with the provisions of the Income-tax Act. The primary objective is to ensure that the returned income reflects the true and correct tax liability of the taxpayer.

Cases are selected for scrutiny based on risk parameters identified through automated systems, information received from third-party sources, or specific issues flagged by the tax authorities.

Procedure for Scrutiny Assessment

1. Selection of Case for Scrutiny

Selection of cases for scrutiny is largely system-driven and carried out through the Computer Aided Scrutiny Selection (CASS) mechanism. Scrutiny may be categorised as:

- Limited Scrutiny, restricted to specific

issues identified at the time of selection, or

- Complete Scrutiny, covering all aspects of the return of income.

2. Issue of Notice under Section 143(2)

The scrutiny process formally commences with the issuance of a notice under Section 143(2) within the prescribed statutory time limit. This notice conveys the intention of the Assessing Officer to examine the return filed by the taxpayer.

3. Issue of Notice under Section 142(1)

To obtain further details, the Assessing Officer may issue a notice under Section 142(1) calling for specific information, explanations, documents or books of accounts. Timely, accurate and complete compliance with such notices is critical for smooth conduct of assessment proceedings.

4. Faceless Assessment Framework

Under the faceless assessment regime, scrutiny assessments are conducted electronically through the income-tax portal, without any physical interaction between the taxpayer and the department. This framework aims to bring greater transparency, eliminate discretion and ensure uniformity in assessment procedures.

5. Draft Assessment Order and Opportunity of Being Heard

Before passing the final assessment order, a draft order is issued setting out the proposed variations. The taxpayer is provided an opportunity to submit a response and, in eligible cases, may also request a personal hearing through video conferencing.

6. Passing of Final Assessment Order

After considering the submissions and available records, the final assessment order is passed electronically along with the demand notice or refund order, as the case may be.

Income-tax Scrutiny Assessments – Procedure, Rights and Practical Insights

Rights and Responsibilities of the Taxpayer

During scrutiny proceedings, taxpayers are entitled to:

- A reasonable opportunity of being heard
- Clear communication of the issues under examination
- A reasoned and speaking assessment order

Correspondingly, taxpayers are responsible for maintaining proper records, ensuring timely compliance with statutory notices and furnishing accurate and complete information.

Practical Insights for Professionals

- Adopt an issue-wise and structured approach while filing submissions, particularly in limited scrutiny cases

- Ensure reconciliation between financial statements, tax audit reports and return of income

- Maintain robust documentation for high-risk areas such as cash transactions, related-party transactions and major deductions claimed

Conclusion

Income-tax scrutiny assessments, when approached with preparedness and professional diligence, need not be adversarial in nature. A clear understanding of procedural requirements, coupled with timely and accurate compliance, can significantly reduce disputes and contribute to a more efficient and fair tax administration system.
